

Floral Planning Checklist for Your Vow Renewal

1. Determine Your Floral Buaget		
□ s	Set a total budget for your vow renewal flowers.	
ПА	allocate specific amounts for key elements (e.g., bridal bouquet, centerpieces, altar flowers).

9. Review and Confirm Final Details		
	Double-check all floral details a week before your vow renewal.	
	Confirm any last-minute changes with your florist or finalize your DIY preparations.	
	Ensure all payments have been made and receipts are kept.
